**Policy** 

#### Policy statement

NZMF has a responsibility to take 'all practicable steps' in providing effective first aid arrangements.

## Purpose

To ensure safe and consistent care is taken when first aid may be required in the workplace.

#### Scope

This policy applies to all NZMF Promoters and Sanctioners.

### Responsibilities

#### The NZMF Sanctioner is responsible for:

- · ensuring qualified first aid responders are provided at the Event
- ensuring that first aid supplies are accessible to Athletes
- ensuring a first aid register form and incident and accident register is completed in the event that serious first aid response is given (refer: NZMF first aid register and accident register)
- ensuring all serious injuries and any and all head trauma is recorded and athletes and their trainers are aware of any stand down period.
- · ensuring that all judges and referees are qualified and of sufficient experience

#### The NZMF Promoter is responsible for:

- ensuring there is qualified first responder first aid representatives at the event (St Johns or equivalent)
- ensuring each athlete has a pre and post medical check performed by a qualified first aid responder
- · ensuring the closest hospital are aware of the event date and times
- ice and water are supplied for athletes
- ensuring that all judges and referees are qualified and of sufficient experience
